The Process and Technology Improvement Grants (PTIG) program is administered by the Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) of the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). Through this competitive grant process, up to \$5 million is awarded annually (contingent upon funding) to State agencies and community-based or faith-based organizations.

These grants support the development and implementation of projects that focus on improving the quality and efficiency of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) operations and processes.
