RE: SNAP – Delaware Request to Adjust SNAP Application Processing
Timeliness in Response to COVID-19 – Denial

Dear Mr. Hall:

This letter transmits the Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) denial of Delaware's request to adjust Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) application processing timeliness requirements.

As you may be aware, section 2302 of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) (P.L. 116-127) allows the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) to provide certain adjustments for flexibilities in SNAP. Adjustments must align with what is practicable with actual conditions in areas affected by the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency, and are limited to issuance methods and application and reporting requirements under the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008, as amended (FNA). FNS has determined that this request does not meet the requirements for approval.

Therefore, FNS is denying the requests that seek to:

- Adjust requirements to process SNAP applications within 30 days at Section 11(e)(3) of the FNA and 7 CFR 273.2(g)(1);
- Adjust requirements to process SNAP applications within 7 days for households entitled to expedited service at Section 11(e)(9) of the FNA and 7 CFR 273.2(i)(3);
- Adjust the definition of opportunity to participate at 7 CFR 274.2(b).

FNS encourages States to use available administrative flexibilities such as online applications and request or use allowable FFCRA adjustments such as interview requirement adjustments to meet the 7- or 30-day timeframes. FNS guidance for States in response to COVID-19 is available at
