1. **May 2022** EA Issuance date(s):

Will occur on the regular staggered issuance date for all on-going SNAP households (5th-23rd odd days only). For newly authorized SNAP households, the EA will be issued on the next day after authorization. The State recognizes that this EA issuance for the month of May cannot be released to the EBT vendor until May 1, 2022 or after and that the public health emergency declaration remains in effect through at least May 1st as well.

2. **May 2022** estimate of the number of households and estimated EA amount:

Number of households receiving emergency allotment benefits: 256,745

Amount of emergency allotment benefits issued per month: \$ 36,997,061
