The estimated amount of P-EBT benefits PR will be issuing under this amendment for <u>school-aged children</u> has been determined as follows: 340,000 estimated students (currently receiving/received P-EBT benefits) multiplied by \$438.00, totals \$148,920,000.00.



To identify summer-PEBT eligible school-aged students, ADSEF will refer to the list of all students that received P-EBT benefits during the last month of the school year 2021. Since, <u>ALL</u> public and private schools have been providing virtual classes until May (end of the school year) they will receive the full summer benefit.

In case of any **new eligible students, they will have until August 6th, 2021, to apply for these benefits through the PR-DOE's NSLP eligibility and application process.** During the covered summer period, students would have to be certified by the PR-DOE in order to receive the P-EBT benefits. ADSEF will post all the details as part of the agency's media outreach and communications campaign.

The estimated amount of P-EBT benefits PR will be issuing under this amendment for <u>children in child-care</u> has been determined as follows: 73,366 estimated NAP household children in child-care multiplied by \$438.00, totals \$32,134,308.00.




Eligibility

To qualify for summer child-care P-EBT benefits, children must be between 0 and 6 years old and live in a **NAP household**. The children's residence zip code will be used to identify schools that have been closed for at least five (5) consecutive days. Only children that have <u>not received</u> benefits from the school-aged students' summer PEBT benefits will be eligible. Children must be NAP-enrolled during the summer period or those whose **NAP enrollment begins** or **ends during** the **summer period** can receive the full summer benefit.

Since all public and private schools in Puerto Rico remain closed, and classes continue to be taught virtually, all child-care NAP children are eligible for the maximum benefits level.

Total of school aged children plus children in childcare is: \$181,134,308.00





Response cont.-

Puerto Rico's Tentative Summer P-EBT Issuance Schedule.

Due to the EBT's programming cost PR proposes to make <u>a single issuance</u> for the aged-school children and child-care summer PEBT benefits. Deposits will be made during the month of **July 2021** (see table below). **Issuances' days will be determined by the last digit of their social security number.** Refer to table below for tentative schedule.
