RE: SNAP – Wisconsin Adjustment Request for Initial Certification and
Recertification Interviews – Extension – Denial (Resubmission)

Dear Ms. McAtee:

This letter transmits the Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) denial of the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) adjustment request (COV-126) to continue to adjust the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) requirement to conduct an interview at initial application and recertification during the month of September 2020.

FNS appreciates the additional data the State provided to demonstrate the need for the adjustment and recognizes that the State is facing challenges in processing initial and ongoing cases for certification at this time due to the COVID-19 public health emergency. However, based on the data submitted by the State, FNS does not find that an extension of the adjustment is necessary to be consistent with what is practicable under actual conditions in the State. FNS would like to work with the State agency on a transition plan that moves the State forward toward operations that are consistent with certification regulations at 7 CFR 273.2(a)(2), 273.2(e), and 273.14(b)(3) immediately.

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FNS stands ready to provide technical assistance and will consider future requests for adjustments in subsequent months if circumstances in the State change, such as a spike in new applications, or the general workload increases, and sufficient data is provided to support these flexibilities during the public health emergency.
