

# Produce Safety University

Presented by the Supplemental Nutrition and Safety Programs, Office of Food Safety

Produce Safety University (PSU) is a train-the-trainer immersion course that arms school nutrition professionals with tools and knowledge to address real life scenarios, critically analyze and respond to food safety issues, and teach others critical food safety concepts and practices. Participants also earn continuing education hours for Professional Standards for school nutrition professionals.

## PSU is far-reaching.



1,650 participants have **graduated since the program began** in 2010.\* On average, **150** participants graduate each year.

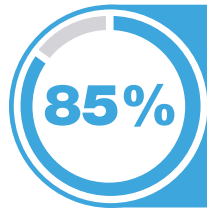


**Additional people have been trained** by graduates.\* On average, each graduate goes on to train **42** people.

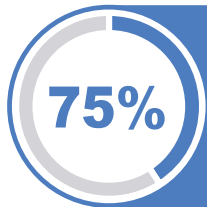
## PSU has lasting impacts.



Of graduates **produce “less or significantly less waste”** in their kitchens than they did before attending PSU.



Of graduates have made **changes to improve receiving, storage, preparation, or service practices** as a result of attending PSU.



Of graduates **increase their use of locally sourced produce.**
