Effective on October 1, 2011, a final rule published June 11, 2010, titled Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program: Quality Control Provisions of Title IV of Public Law 107-171, that expanded the scope of the assessment for Fiscal Year 2012 as compared to prior fiscal years. The assessment now includes an assessing compliance with Federal procedural requirements to determine the timeliness of the action, and to adhere to requirements for notices of termination, denials, and suspensions. State agencies must notify the household using clear and understandable language in support of Agency goals to improve customer service.
